### Issue of EUR 500,000,000 0.625 per cent. Fixed Rate Notes due 3 July 2019 (the Notes) under the €60,000,000,000 Debt Issuance Program

This document constitutes the Final Terms relating to the issue of Notes described herein. Terms used herein shall be deemed to be defined as such for the purposes of the Terms and Conditions of the Notes (the **Conditions**) set forth in the Base Prospectus dated 28 April 2014 and the supplemental base prospectus dated 3 June 2014 which together constitute a base prospectus for the purposes of Directive 2003/71/EC (the '**Prospectus Directive**' which term includes Directive 2010/73/EU (the '**2010 PD Amending Directive**') to the extent implemented in a relevant member state of the European Economic Area in which the Notes are issued (each, a 'Relevant Member State')). Projects financed by the Water Authorities will be according to the Mandate given to the Water Authorities and managed by the Water Authorities and defined through the Dutch Water Act (<i>Waterwet</i>). The mandate of the Water Authorities is to do water management through mitigation, adaptation and biodiversity projects inside following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Energy reduction and biogas production</li> <li>- Reuse of nutrients and other substances</li> <li>- Transport and treatment of wastewater</li> <li>- Flood protection infrastructure</li> <li>- Irrigation and drainage, pumping stations</li> <li>- (Re)design of watercourses and wetlands for water storage and discharge</li> <li>- Sanitation and dredging and waterbeds</li> <li>- Improving water quality</li> </ul> <p>An annual external audit of the earmarked account will confirm the lending done and transparency on the projects financed will be provided through general reporting from the Water Authorities and summarised through an annual investor letter provided by NWB Bank. It is the ambition of NWB Bank to spend the proceeds from the Green Bonds in their lending to the Water Authorities throughout 2014.</p>


